The Historic Wooden Boat *Mary Jemison*
Departing from Corn Hill Landing, Downtown Rochester, New York



Cruise the Upper Genesee River extension of the Erie Canal on the vintage 1930s wooden boat *Mary Jemison*. Hear the story of the river that gave life to Rochester, while viewing the new waterside development that is making Rochester the most distinctive urban port on the Erie Canal. Travel through the picturesque crossing of the river and canal in Genesee Valley Park and return to a spectacular view of the contemporary city skyline.

May through October season.

- 63-1/2 foot double decked wooden boat, adapted from a 1931 Chesapeake Bay Buy Boat.
- U.S. Coast Guard Certified.
- Enclosed Main Cabin, open-air bow and open-air upper deck.
